- * Located across the street from Amherst-Steele HS. (During inclement weather we will be in the HS).
- * Participants must be entering Kindergarten
- * Your child will be learning sideline chants, cheers, and dances. They also may be taught cheerleading jumps, cartwheels, etc. Teambuilding games and other fun activities fill the rest of our schedule. Please be assured that your child's safety is our #1 priority.
- * Please wear appropriate clothing: shorts, T-shirts, supportive athletic shoes, and socks.
- * Please bring a healthy sack lunch and drink. Drinks with sugar attract bees. **Water is preferred!**
- * Please put your name on **EVERYTHING**.
- * Day 1- Do not arrive before 9:15. The high school cheerleaders will be practicing until then.
Day 2- "Crazy Spirit Day"
Day 3- Green and Gold Day. We will also be having a performance for you to come watch your children, starting around 1 p.m. They will go by grade/group and perform a portion of what they have learned.
- * The Varsity game they will be cheering at is Friday, August 26, at 7:00 p.m. If there is inclement weather, the rain date is scheduled for Friday, September 23. We will have them do the cheers they learn at the clinic during the 2nd quarter of the game. They are to arrive in the T-shirt they receive at the clinic and a pair of black pants (or black shorts if it is particularly warm). If it is chilly, please layer a white turtleneck under the T-shirt. Hair should be pulled back. On the day of the game, we will be meeting in the high school lobby (located by the main basketball gym). Please arrive between 6:15 and 6:30, so the high school cheerleaders can review the material with them before they take their reserved seats for the game.
- * Game tickets for parents, friends, and other family members should be purchased on the last day of the cheer clinic to alleviate any long lines at the gate. Please bring exact change. Tickets are \$6 each.
