

Parents of students attending a school receiving Title I funds in Amherst Exempted Village schools, have a right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct their children. If requested by parents, the Federal “No Child Left Behind Act of 2001,” requires us to provide certain information about classroom teachers in a timely manner.

Specifically, parents have the right to ask for the following information about their child’s classroom teachers:

- Whether the teacher has met Ohio's qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level(s) and subject matter he or she teaches.
- Whether Ohio has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teacher’s college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any paraprofessional educators provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
